- Marketing Box - From Harry Potter complete collection to Ram Mandir, it was all made out of a box. Judged by our professor Kane, students gained insight into how to sell ideas out of a box.
- 120 Seconds - From ways to curb air pollution, to solutions to the world education problem, 120 seconds was an event of pitching rapidly. Participants pitched from a variety of topics and selected the one they wish to make a change in.
